SERVICE: *You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love.* Galatians 5:13

KINDNESS, COMPASSION OR FORGIVENESS: *Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.* Ephesians 4:32

ENCOURAGEMENT: *Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.* 1 Thessalonians 5:11

HOSPITALITY: *Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.* 1 Peter 4:9

HARMONY: *Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble.* 1 Peter 3:8

INSTRUCTION: *I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to instruct one another.* Romans 15:14

MOTIVATING: *And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.* Hebrews 10:24

CARE: *... so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other.* 1 Corinthians 12:25

PEACE: *“Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and be at peace with each other.”* Mark 9:50

BUILDING UP: *Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.* 1 Thessalonians 5:11
