



2003 Lent

Perpetua and Felicity Humbly accept God's word in your life. Never put a question mark where God puts a period. Ask for God's healing. Start with yourself if you want to put the world right! (Psalm 31).

How deeply do you love Him? (Mk 12:30)	9 Simon helps Jesus carry the cross. Extend yourself for another in need. Love sees through a telescope, not a microscope. (Lk. 10:29-37).	10 Veronica wipes Jesus' face His image is on her cloth but also on the faces of the sick and the needy you meet. Phone/visit them. (Pet. 1:22-25; Jam. 2:14-26).	11 Jesus falls again Who forgives most, shall be most forgiven. How might this apply to your life? (Lk. 15:11-12, 20, 32).	12 St. Stainislaus Women weep for Jesus. Jesus tells us to weep for our sins. Have courage to speak up on moral issues! (Jn. 8:12-20).
13 Passion/Palm Sunday Sin is the betrayal of our love for Jesus. Those who stand for nothing fall for everything. Repent. Observe Holy week. (Lk. 11:1-4)	14 Jesus falls the third time. When have you last been to confession? Be contrite. Take courage, get up and go now. (Jn. 12:1-11).	15 Stripped of His clothing We must not look down on anyone. The greater sin could be ours! Strip yourself of sinful habits. (Lk. Chap. 15).	16 Jesus nailed to the cross. Don't seek to take the splinter from your neighbor's eye, until you have removed the plank from your own! (Mt. 7:1-5)	17 Holy Thursday Be washed by Him. Receive His Body and Blood. Recall the Last Supper. Trust in the Lord with all your heart. (Prov. 3:5; Jn. 13:7)	18 Good Friday (fast) It was LOVE that held Jesus to the crossnot just nails. He suffered and died for your sins. Reflect quietly in prayer. (Jn. Chaps. 18-19)	19 Holy Saturday The Gospels do not explain Easter. Easter explains the Gospels. Jesus' power will transform you , if you let Him. (Eph. 3:20; Jn. 20:17-18).

Easter Sunday

Let no one mourn that he/she has fallen again and again, for forgiveness has risen from the grave. Let no one fear death, for the death of our Savior has set us free. He has destroyed it by enduring it. He spoiled the power of Hell when He descended there. Isaiah fortold this when he cried, "Death has been frustrated in meeting Him below."
