# Roadblocks to Effective Communication



There are some methods which tend to intensify problems rather than alleviate problems. These are called Roadblocks to Effective Communication. The Twelve Roadblocks are:

#### Judging

- 1. Judging, criticizing, blaming: "That's really immature."
- 2. Name-calling, ridiculing: "Okay, you little baby."
- 3. Interpreting, diagnosing: "You're just jealous of \_\_
- 4. Praising, agreeing: "Well, I think you're pretty/smart/a good player."

#### Sending Solutions

- 5. Ordering, directing, commanding: "Don't ever talk to me like that!"
- 6. Warning, admonishing, threatening: "If you do that, you'll be sorry."
- 7. Exhorting, moralizing, preaching: "You ought to do this..."
- 8. Excessive/inappropriate questioning: "Why do you suppose you have school?"

### Avoiding the Other's Concerns

- 9. Advising or giving solutions: "Go make friends with someone else."
- 10. Diverting, distracting: "Why don't you try burning down the school?"
- 11. Lecturing, teaching, giving logical arguments: "Let's look at the facts..."
- 12. Reassuring, sympathizing: "Don't worry, things will work out fine."
