TOPIC: Parents

SCRIPTURE: Colossians 3:12-17,20

SUPPLIES: 1 ball of yarn per person (include a variety of colors), scissors

ave youth form groups of three. Give each group a pair of scissors and three balls of yarn in three different colors. Instruct each group to appoint one person as the "binder." That person will tie the other two team members together as quickly as possible.

The pair of youth to be tied together should stand back to back. The binder must tie the pair at their ankles, knees, hips, hands, and heads. At each point, the binder must use all three colors of yarn. The first group to be successfully tied at all five spots wins.
