Huddle Hustle

TOPIC: Family

SCRIPTURE: Genesis 45:1-15

SUPPLIES: masking tape

B efore the game, use masking tape to mark a starting line and a finish line several feet apart.

Have teenagers form teams of five to ten. Ask each team to stand in a huddle, as close together as possible. Encourage teams to hold on tightly to one another—if a huddle is broken, that team will forfeit. Tell teams to stand behind the starting line until you say go. When you give the signal, huddles should race to the finish line.

- Read Genesis 45:1-15 aloud. How does this account show the importance Joseph placed on family?
- · What things today might test even the strongest family?
- · What can a family do to grow closer?
- · Why is forgiveness an important part of family life?

- What can you do to show your family members they're important to you?
