The Pain of a Lost World

- Every day, 25,000 people—most of them children—die from the results of dirty drinking water.
- More than 1.1 billion people live on less than \$1 a day in U.S. currency.
- One out of every four human beings do not have access to health care.
- Half the world's people can't vote.
- The number of refugees has exploded from 3 million in 1970 to more than 25 million today. Another 27 million are displaced within their own countries.
