Two Left Hands

TOPIC: Love

SCRIPTURE: 1 Corinthians 13:13; Galatians 5:22-23

SUPPLIES: 1 banana per pair, 1 orange per pair, variety of other fruits, chairs,

blindfolds

ave participants form pairs. One person from each pair should sit in a chair while that person's partner stands behind the chair. Every seated person should be blindfolded.

The person standing up will lend his or her left hand to the person sitting down. The person sitting down can use only his or her left hand, so each sitting person has the use of two left hands.

Give each pair a banana and an orange, and distribute any other fruit evenly among pairs. When the contest begins, each pair must peel the banana and the orange and any other fruit with its two left hands. The person standing up must feed all the fruit to the person sitting down. Pairs should try to eat all their fruit as quickly as possible.

- How does love change people's lives?
