

- Q: Why do you think so many people live in isolation, thinking and feeling as though they are the only ones dealing with specific issues?
  - Do you think there's any solution to that? What could one be?
- Q: Someone has to go first. What do you think it takes to be that person?
  - How does sharing with another person relate to our responsibility toward them?
  - What do you think that costs?
  - What do you believe it's worth? Why?

To help students further realize how their story might be shared, use the questions from **Alone Together** (page 161 in this book) for additional large or small group discussion, or possibly as a tool for individual, personal reflection.
