## Turban Tag

TOPIC: Unity

SCRIPTURE: Philippians 2:1-11 SUPPLIES: 1 towel per person

ive each person a towel, and instruct players to wrap the towels securely around their heads like turbans. Explain that there are no teams in this game. Everyone should try to knock the turbans off the heads of opponents while protecting the turban on his or her own head. When a person's turban is knocked off, that person is out of the game.

## **LEADER TIP**

Allow participants to use their hands in the first few rounds, but later, for an extra challenge, try a round with no hands.

If necessary, remind players to be careful and not to hit other people. The winner is the last person with a turban on his or her head.

- Can you share a time you put someone else's needs ahead of your own?
- What benefits can we enjoy by working toward this sort of unselfish attitude in our group?
