ENCOURAGEMENT: Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, 1 Thessalonians 5:11 just as in fact you are doing.

HOSPITALITY: Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. 1 Peter 4:9

HARMONY: Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, 1 Peter 3:8 love as brothers, be compassionate and humble.

INSTRUCTION: I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to instruct one another.

MOTIVATING: And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love Hebrews 10:24 and good deeds.

CARE: ... so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should 1 Corinthians 12:25 have equal concern for each other.

PEACE: "Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Mark 9:50 Have salt in yourselves, and be at peace with each other."
