Spanish-Language Characters on the Computer

There are other ways to produce Spanish-language characters on the computer, such as using Spanish word processors or changing keyboard templates, etc., but these codes are for those who write only occasionally in Spanish.

First, make sure your numerical lock is "on". (NUM LOCK)
For each character, hold down the "ALT" key while you type the indicated number ON
THE NUMERICAL KEYPAD, NOT on the row of numbers on the top of the keyboard,
then release, and the accented or special character will appear.

Hold down ALT, and type:	Release ALT, and you'll get:
