Can I Quote You?

TOPIC: The Future

SCRIPTURE: Romans 8:28-39

SUPPLIES: several books and calendars containing quotations, Bibles, slips of

paper, pens or pencils, bowl

Instruct each person to use the books, calendars, and Bibles to select a quotation to incorporate into his or her planning for the future. Once everyone has chosen a quotation, have youth write their quotations on slips of paper. Place all the slips in a bowl.

One at a time, have participants draw a slip from the bowl and read the quotation aloud to the group. Each person must try to guess who chose the quotation on the slip he or she picked from the bowl. If the guess is incorrect, allow the rest of the group to guess. If no one can guess, the person who chose the quotation should reveal his or her identity.

Repeat the drawing and guessing until all the quotations have been selected, read, and matched with the appropriate people.

DISCUSSION

- How does the quotation you picked affect the way you face the future?
- · How can the wisdom of others help you reach your goals?
- How can God's Word help us face the uncertainties of the future?
