Question to Consider: When will I take the time to write down my answers to life's five great questions?
When will I put my purpose on paper?

DAY One
IT'S NOT ABOUT ME

Life is about being what God created me to be. God is the source of my life. He planned my creation before I was even born and my purpose fits into God's larger plan for all of creation. I discover my identity & purpose through a relationship with Jesus.
Life without God makes no sense.

Verse to remember: Everything got started in Him & finds its purpose in Him. Col 1:16

Question to consider: How can I remind myself that life is really about living for God not me?

DAY Two
I am not an accident.

I was custom-made. God creates everything intentionally & planned every detail of me, and the details of my life.

Question to Consider: What areas of my personality, background, and physical appearance am I struggling to accept?

Verse to remember: I am your creator. You were in my care before you were born. Isaiah 44:2

DAY THIRTY-NINE:
Blessed are the balanced.

Balance helps me to last. I need to give myself a regular spiritual check up & keep focused on Jesus' Great Commandment & Great Commission:

- 1- Love God with all my heart **Worship**
- 2- Love my neighbor as myself **Ministry**
- 3- Go & make disciples **Evangelization**
- 4- Baptize them **Fellowship**
- 5- Teach them to do all things **Discipleship**

Verse to Remember: "Live life with a due sense of responsibility, not as those who do not know the meaning of life but as those who do." Ephesians 5:15

Question to Consider: Which of the activities will I begin in order to stay on track and balance God's five purposes for my life?

DAY THIRTY-EIGHT:

The Great Commission is my Commission

My joy, confidence & enthusiasm are contagious because I know I am making a difference. Each day I expect God will work through me in fresh ways.

Shifting:

- * from thinking of myself to thinking about others. People my reject my love or my message, but they are
- * from thinking local to global
- *from limited thinking to eternal thinking
- *from excuses to creative ways to fulfill my mission

defenseless against my prayers

Verse to Remember: Send us around the world with the news of your saving power and your eternal plan for all mankind. Psalm 67:2

Question to Consider: What steps can I take to prepare to go on a short-term missions experience in the next year?

Day Three

Living on purpose is the path to peace.

What drives me? Guilt?, Anger?, Fear?, Materialism?,
Need for Approval?

Knowing my purpose:

- * gives meaning to my life
- * simplifies my life
- * focuses my life
- * motivates my life
- * prepares me for heaven

Questions to Consider: What would my family and friends say is the driving force of my life? What do I want it to be?

Verse to remember: You Lord give perfect peace to those who keep their purpose firm and put their trust in you.

Isaiah 26:3

Day Four

There is more to life than just here and now.

This life is not all there is. Death is not the end. I will spend far more time in eternity & this life is a preparation for that.

Verse to Remember: This world is fading away, along with everything it craves. But if you do the will of God) you will live forever.

1 John 2:17

Question to Consider: Since I was made to last forever, what is the one thing I should stop doing and the one thing I should start doing today?

DAY THIRTY-SEVEN:
God wants to say something to the world
through me.

I am God's messenger through:

*My Story- how I was before Jesus, how I needed Him,
committed to Him & the difference He has
made in my life

*My Life lessons- what God has taught me through:

failure
pain, sorrow or depression
waiting
lack
disappointment
illness/ injury
family, friends, enemies

*My Passions- God gives us of us different passions so that everything he wants
done in the world will get done. I should not expect everyone else to be
as passionate about my passion.

*The Good News message of salvation- I teach through my life

Verse to Remember: Be ready at all times to answer anyone who asks you to explain the
hope you have in you, but do it with gentleness and respect. 1 Peter 3:15-16

Question to Consider: As I reflect on my personal story,
who does God want me to share it with?

DAY THIRTY-SIX :

I was made for a mission.

My mission is a privilege- it is a continuation of Jesus' saving mission on earth. My mission gives my life its meaning & has an eternal meaning

Verse to Remember: Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age. Matt 28:19-20

Questions to Consider: What fears have kept me from fulfilling the mission God made me to accomplish? What keeps me from telling others the Good News?

Day FIVE

Life is a test and a trust.

The way I see my life shapes my life. How do I see it?
Life is a test which shows & shapes my character.
Life on earth is a gift God trusts me with. The more God gives me the more responsible He expects me to be.

Verse to Remember: "Unless you are faithful in small matters you won't be faithful in large ones. Luke 16:10

Questions to Consider: What has happened to me recently that I now realize was a test from God? What are the greatest matters God has entrusted to me?

DAY SIX

This world is not my home.

Life on earth is a temporary assignment. Who I am & where I belong is in eternity.

Verse to Remember: So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary but what is unseen is eternal. 2 Corinthians 4:18

Question to Consider: How should the fact that life on earth is just a temporary assignment change the way I am living right now?

DAY THIRTY-FIVE:

God works best when I admit my weakness.

God is never limited by my limitations. He loves to use weak people. If he only used perfect people, nothing would ever get done.

I need to:

- *Admit my weaknesses & not pretend to have it all together.
- *Be content with my weaknesses- knowing God will use all for His glory
- *Share my weaknesses- feelings, failures, frustrations, fears

Verse to Remember: My grace is sufficient for you, my power is made perfect in weakness. 2 Corinthians 12:9

Questions to Consider: Am I limiting God's power in my life by trying to hide my weaknesses? What do I need to be honest about in order to help others?

DAY THIRTY-FOUR:

To be a servant I must think like a servant.

Service starts in the mind:

- *Thinking more about others than myself

- *Remembering I am not the owner of anything in this reality- God is
- *Focusing on my work- not on what others are doing
- *Basing my identity in Jesus
- *Seeing my work as an opportunity, not an obligation

Verse to Remember: Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus. Philippians 2: 5

Question to Consider: Am I usually more concerned about being served or finding ways to serve others?

DAY SEVEN

It's all for him.

The whole universe shows the glory of God. Living for God's glory is the greatest thing I can accomplish with my life. I decide who am I going to live for: me or God?

I bring glory to God by:

- * Worshiping Him
- * Loving others as He Loves
- * Becoming Like Jesus
- *Serving others with our gifts
- *Spreading the Good News

Verse to Remember: For everything comes from God alone. Everything lives by his power, and everything is for his glory. Romans 11:36

Question to Consider: Where in my daily routine can I become more aware of God's glory?

DAY EIGHT:

I was planned for God's pleasure.

I can make God smile, this is my greatest accomplishment. My whole life is an act of worshipping God- bringing Him joy.

Verse to Remember: The Lord takes pleasure in his people. Ps 149:4

Question to Consider: What common task could I start doing as if I were doing it directly for Jesus?

DAY THIRTY-THREE :

I serve God by serving others.

As a real servant of God:

- *I make myself available to serve others
- *I pay attention to the needs of others
- *I do the best with what I have
- *I do everything with the same dedication- with all my heart, the size is irrelevant
- *I remember that the little things determine the big things. Great opportunities
- disguise themselves in little tasks. I don't look to do great things for God. I am
- willing to do the not so great stuff; remembering that nothing was beneath Jesus
- because He came to serve. The Son of God washed feet, helped
- children, served lepers, helped with meals.
- *I remain faithful to my ministry
- *I keep a low profile- i don't call attention to myself

Verse to Remember: If you give even a cup of cold water you will surely be rewarded.

Question to Consider: Which of the six characteristics of greatest challenge to me?

DAY THIRTY-TWO :
God deserves my best.

God wants me to focus on talents He gave me to use.
When I don't it wastes my time, talent & energy.

So I need to:

- *Look at my gifts & abilities
- *Look at my heart & my personality
- *Look at my experiences & the lessons I have gained from them

God has given me a job to do, my goal is to stay within the boundaries of His plan for me. The devil will try to steal the joy of service away by tempting me to:
-compare my mission with others
-conform my mission with others

Verse to Remember: Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.
2 Timothy 2:15

Question: How can I make the best use of what God has given me?

DAY NINE:
God smiles when I trust him.

The smile of God is the goal of my life. All I need to do in please God & then do it.

this life is to figure out what will

God smiles when:

- *I love Him more than anything else
- *I trust Him completely
- *I obey Him wholeheartedly
- *I praise & thank Him continually
- *I use my abilities

Verse to Remember: The Lord is pleased with those who

Question to Consider: Since God knows what is best, in need to trust him most?

DAY TEN:
The heart of worship is surrender.

To give my whole self to God I have to trust Him.
3 things keep me from doing this:

-fear- The more I realize His love for me, the more I will be able to trust Him.

-pride- I need to be completely honest about my limitations- I can give God everything- my problems, weakness, bad habits, fears, dreams, hurts

-confusion- God works through those who have surrendered to Him- I am willing to do something I do not feel like doing

Verse to Remember: Surrender your whole being to him to be used for righteous purposes. Romans 6:13

Question to Consider: What area of my life am I holding back from God?

DAY THIRTY-ONE:

Nobody else can be me.

I make a contribution to the body of Christ that no one else can make. All my abilities come from God. The church's responsibility is to identify & release my abilities for serving God. What I am able to do, God wants me to do. He matches my calling & my abilities. I need to discover what I am good at & what I am not good at. God has been shaping me through experiences out of my control:

*Family

*Education

*Work

*Spiritual

*Serving

*Pain

Verse to Remember: God has given each of you some special abilities; be sure to use them to help each other, passing on to others God's many kinds of blessings.

1 Peter 4:10

Question to Consider: What God-given ability or personal experience can I offer to my church?

DAY THIRTY:

I was shaped for serving God.

God shapes me for my mission & I need to unwrap my spiritual gifts. These can't be earned, chosen or deserved- they are gifts- expressions of God's love for me, that He chose for the benefit of others, just as other people are gifts for my benefit.

2 problems to avoid:

1- gift envy- jealous of how God works through others

2-gift projections- expected others to have same gifts as me

Verse to Remember: God works through different men in different ways but it is the same God who achieves

his purposes through them all. 1Cor12:6

Question to Consider: In what way can I see myself passionately serving others and loving it?

DAY ELEVEN:

God wants to be my best friend.

I was made to live in the presence of God.

I become best friends with Jesus by constant conversation- sharing all my life with Him. Everything I do is spending time with God

Verse to Remember: Friendship with God is reserved I for those who reverence him. Psalm 25:14

Question to Consider: What can I do to remind myself to think about God and remember to talk with him more often throughout the day?

DAY TWELVE:

I'm as close to God as I choose to be.

There is nothing more important than my friendship with God. Growing in this friendship takes:

*honesty- God does not require me to be perfect, but he does	want complete honesty
*desire- I have to want my friendship with God more than anything else. I have to value what is important to God.	Pain energizes us with intensity to change.
*time & energy- Every time I obey God & act in faith our	friendship deepens

Verse to Remember: Draw close to God and God will draw close to you. James 4:8

Question to Consider: What practical choices will I make today in order to grow closer to God?

DAY TWENTY-NINE:

Service is not optional.

I was put on earth to make a difference. I was created to serve God by making a contribution. I was saved by Jesus to serve God. To grow spiritually is not for its own sake. I grow up so I can give out.

Verse to Remember: "For we are God's workmanship created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:10

Question to Consider: What is holding me back from accepting God's call to serve him?

DAY TWENTY-EIGHT:

There are no shortcuts to maturity.

God is not interested in how fast I grow- but in how strong I grow.

Growing can take a long time:

- I'm a slow learner
- I have a lot to unlearn
- I'm afraid to face the truth about myself
- Growing is often painful & scary
- Habits take time to grow

What I can do:

- *Believe God is working in my life even when I don't feel it
- *Keep a journal of lessons learned
- *Be patient with God & myself
- *Don't get discouraged

Verse to Remember: God began doing a good work in you and I am sure he will continue it until it is finished when Jesus Christ comes again. Philippians 1:6

Question to Consider: In what area of my spiritual growth do I need to be more patient and persistent?

DAY THIRTEEN:

God wants all of me.

God does not want to be part of my life. He asks for all

DAY FOURTEEN:

God is real, no matter how I feel.

Friendships are often tested by separation & silence &
with God it is no different. He is close to me even when
I do not feel close to Him.

When i feel separated from God I can remember to trust
HIm & that He keeps His promises:

- *He is good & loving
- *He is all powerful
- *He notices every detail of my life
- *He is in control
- *He has a plan for my life
- *He will save me

Verse to Remember: "For God has said, 'I will never leave
you. I will never abandon you. Hebrews 13:5

Question to Consider: How can I stay focused on God's
presence, especially when he feels distant?

DAY TWENTY-SEVEN:

There is always a way through

DAY TWENTY-SIX:

Every temptation is an opportunity to do good.

God uses temptation to help you grow. The fruits of the
Holy Spirit grow through the experience of circumstances
where I am tempted to express the opposite quality

All temptations follow the same pattern:

1- desire within

2- doubt that it's really that wrong

3-deception

4- disobedience

It's not a sin to be tempted, only when I give in to it.
I can't block out all temptations, but I can choose
not to dwell on or act on them.

How I can overcome temptation:

- *Refuse to be intimidated- I am not alone
- *Recognize my pattern of temptation & be prepared for it
- *Ask for God's help

Verse to Remember: God blesses the people who patiently endure testing. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

James 1:12

Question to Consider: What Christlike character quality can I develop by defeating the most common temptation I face?

DAY FIFTEEN:

I was formed for God's family.

God doesn't need, but wants a family & I was created to be part of it. Because
God is love, He treasures relationships. The Holy Trinity is God's
relationship with Himself- Father, Son & Holy Spirit. My spiritual family is more
important than anything, because it will last forever. Being
included in God's family is the greatest honor & privilege I will ever receive.

Verse to Remember: "His unchanging plan has always been to adopt us into
his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 1:5

Question to Consider: How can I start treating other believers like members
of my own family?

DAY SIXTEEN:

Life is all about love.

Because God is love, the most important lesson He wants me to learn on earth is how to love and so the best use of life is love. Life without love is really worthless because only love lasts forever. How I treat people is the only thing I will do on earth that endures. It's not what I do, but how much love I put into the doing that matters. Love is the only thing God will care about when I enter eternity. My character is the only thing I take with me. Faith expressing itself in love.

Learning to love unselfishly is not easy. The best expression of love is time. T-I-M-E is the best way to spell love & is always a measure of how important something is to me. Focused attention is the most desired gift of love- being present to someone, "I sacrifice myself now for you." The best use of life is love, the best expression of love is time & the best time to love is now.

Verse to Remember: The entire law is summed up in a single command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."
Galatians 5:14

Question to Consider: Honestly, are relationships my first priority? How can I make sure that they are?

DAY TWENTY-FIVE:

There is a purpose behind every problem.

Everything that happens to me has a spiritual meaning. What happens on the outside is not as important as what happens inside me. Jesus taught me to pray "your will be done on earth as it is in heaven". I trust that God's plan is good. I can remember to see the big picture & not give in to short-term thinking. I can give thanks & refuse to give

Verse to Remember: And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. Romans 8:28

Question to Consider: What problem in my life has caused the greatest growth in me?

DAY TWENTY-FOUR:
The truth transforms me.

The spirit of God uses the Word of God to make us like the Son of God.

Living in God's Word:

*accept it as God's Word

*make it's truth part of my everyday life

Verse to Remember: "If you continue in my word, then are you my disciples indeed; and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. John 8:31-32

Question to Consider: What has God already told me in his Word that I haven't started doing yet?

DAY SEVENTEEN:
I am called to belong, not just believe.

I discover my role in life through my relationships with others.

Why i need my spiritual family:

*church identifies me as a true believer

*church moves me out of self-centered isolation

*church helps me grow spiritual muscles

*church keeps me from backsliding

*church gives me the chance to share in Christ's mission in the world

and:

***The Body of Christ needs me**

Verse to Remember: In Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

Romans 12:5

Question to Consider: Does my level of involvement in my local church demonstrate that I love and am committed to God's family?

DAY EIGHTEEN:

I need others in my life.

We came here together. Life is meant to be shared. God intends for us to experience life together.

Real friendship happens when:

*we are real with each other

*we give & receive love freely

*we have sympathy- entering in & experiencing the pain of others

*we have mercy- don't rub mistakes in each others faces- no grudges, because bitterness & resentment always destroy friendship. When others hurt me I have to decide: retaliation or resolution? I can't do both. Forgiveness must be immediate, trust must be rebuilt over time.

Verse to Remember: Share each other's troubles and problems and in this way obey the law of Christ.

Galatians 6:2

Question to Consider: What one step can I take today to connect with another believer at a more genuine, heart-to-heart level?

DAY TWENTY-THREE:

It is never too late to start growing.

God wants me to grow up, and to do this takes commitment. To change my life I have to change the way I think, because that determines the way I feel which influences the way I act. I need to develop the mind of Jesus.

Verse to Remember: Let God transform you inwardly by a complete change of your mind. Then you will be able to know the will of God-what is good and is pleasing to him and is perfect. Romans 12:2

Question to Consider: What is one area where I need to stop thinking my way and start thinking God's way?

DAY TWENTY-TWO:

I was created to become like Christ.

I am a spiritual being that will outlast my physical body. God's plan for my life on earth is not comfort, but the growth of my character. My character is the sum of my habits. I am not entitled to heaven on earth, but God's Holy Spirit is with me. All I have to do is cooperate with the Holy Spirit's work. God uses His Word, people & circumstances to mold me. Becoming like Christ is a slow lifelong process of growing. God is way more interested in what I am, than what I do. Jesus did not die just for me to have a comfortable, well-adjusted life.

Verse to Remember: As the Spirit of the Lord works within us, we become more and more like him and reflect his glory even more. 2 Corinthians 3:18

Question to Consider: In what area of my life do I need to ask for the Spirit's power to be like Christ today?

DAY NINETEEN:

Community requires commitment.

Only the Holy Spirit can create real friendship between believers, but He works through the choices & commitments we make. Christian community takes both God's power & our effort.

Community requires:

- *Honesty- an honest answer is the sign of true friendship
- *Humility- nothing destroys it more than pride & ego- which build walls instead of the bridges that humility builds. Humility is not thinking less of myself; it is thinking of myself less.
- *Courtesy- respect
- *Confidentiality- no gossip
- *Time- regular contact needed to bond

Verse to Remember: We understand what love is when we realize that Christ gave his life for us. That means we must give our lives for other believers. 1 John 3: 16

Question to Consider: How can I help cultivate today the characteristics of real community in my group and my church?

DAY TWENTY:

Relationships are always worth restoring.

Peacemaking is not avoiding conflict or saying anything goes.

How I can restore relationships:

- *Talk to God before talking with the person
- *Make the first move
- *Sympathize with their feelings

*Admit my part in the conflict

*Attack the problem, not the person - don't be obsessed with blaming, remember how I say it is as important as what I say

*Cooperate as much as possible

*Reconciliation of the relationship is more important than resolution of the problem

Verse to Remember: Do everything possible on your part to live in peace with everybody. Romans 12:18

Question to Consider: Who do I need to restore a broken relationship with today?

DAY TWENTY-ONE:

It is my responsibility to protect the unity of my church.

Nothing on earth is more important to God than His family.
I can help protect His Church by:

*Focusing on what we have in common more than differences

*Being realistic in what I expect

*Choosing to encourage more than criticize. Passionately loving the Church in spite of its imperfections

*Refusing to gossip & listen to it

*practicing Gods plan for resolving conflicts:

1- someone hurts me- work it out between us

2-if they won't listen take along several others as witnesses

3- if they still won't listen- tell the church

*Support my pastor & leaders

Verse to Remember: Let us concentrate on the things which make for harmony and the growth of our fellowship together. Romans 14:19

Question to Consider: What am I personally doing to protect unity in my church family right now?
