Better grades tend to come from high school students whose parents are actively involved in their lives, according to a U.S. Department of Education survey of 30,000 students.

The survey shows the percentages of parents who know their kids' whereabouts for these average grades achieved by the students:

Mostly A's 88 percent
Mostly B's 81 percent
Mostly C's 72 percent
Mostly D's 61 percent
