Ten Tips For Working With Youth

□	Share the responsibility for leadership. Provide guidance but avoid total control.
	Listen carefully to youth and try to understand their perspective.
	Provide meaningful roles and assignments for youth.
	Share all work activities, even tedious ones.
	Treat young people as equals and develop a partner relationship.
□	Keep youth informed about activities, even when problems occur.
	Be energetic and excited about activities. Have a positive, open attitude.
	Make activities fun and challenging.
□	Be clear about levels of authority for youth and back their decisions when they fall within the agreed upon guidelines.
□	Serve as role models for the youth, and be consistent and fair in your actions.
