THE 4 IMPERATIVES

I had not heard from this young woman for years. The day after graduation she launched herself into a life that would later be littered with poor choices and heartbreak. After all those years with her, I simply felt like a failure. But then today I got an email from her: "Thank you—you have no idea how much my time with you changed my life." So, what made the difference for her? Here's what she said...

Active Listening—"You didn't just hear my words, but listened to my life. I always knew that you were safe. It always felt like I did most of the talking."

Never Give Up—"You challenged me to be more. When I fell down, you pointed me to Christ to pick me up.

You never thought I was a failure. You loved me when I was unlovable."

Transparency—"You didn't have all the answers. When you made mistakes you admitted them. You never pretended to be anything that you weren't."

Truth—"The hardest part was that you always pointed to the truth. You showed me how Christ wanted me to live. At the time I didn't want to hear it."

Tears well up as I realize the difference a few simple imperatives can make.
