

Characteristics of Catechesis with Young People as described by the

General Directory for Catechesis (GDC 184,185)

Catechesis that:

- considers the diversity of the religious situation of each young person
 - is given in the context of wider pastoral care
 - · addresses problems facing their lives
 - · includes well organized group action
 - provides personal accompaniment and spiritual direction



- includes specific themes as well as other kinds of occasional and informal meetings
 - proposed in new ways
- theological, ethical, historical and social in nature



- formation of conscience and education for love
 - · vocational discernment
 - · missionary dimension
 - · humanitarian nature
- translation into their "language" (mentality, sensibility, tastes, style, vocabulary) the message of Jesus with patience and wisdom without betrayal
