connect through p.e.a.k. groups

With more than 100 kids showing up on Wednesday night, it was impossible to keep up with their needs. So I created PEAK groups—Prayer, Encouragement, Accountability, and Knowing God and each other.

I have the groups of eight to 10 same-sex teenagers (each with an adult leader) meet for 10 minutes before the service starts. It's easier to find adults willing to invest in a 10-minute meeting. I change up the groups every three months so kids and adults get to know each other. Leaders list attendance and prayer requests—I look through them later. It's a great way to keep up.
