

The group is divided into carloads, each with a car and a driver. Each car is given a sheet of questions that must be answered. The location indicated in the last question on every sheet is a checkpoint

where each car and time is recorded and a new route sheet is given. Each car also receives an emergency envelope that is not to be opened until a specified hour. Drivers receive a handout of instructions (page 195). Winners will be judged by time, mileage, and the number correct. The emergency envelope contains the location of the after-rally party. If the cars finish all the route sheets, then the last location will be the address of the party. The first car to arrive wins.
