## Football Stadium

This small-group experience uses the magery of a football game to help nembers of the group not only to learn nore about each other, but to celebrate each others' gifts and position in the ody of Christ. Each person answers to uestion, "If the Christian life were a ootball game, where would you fit in nd why?" One person, for example, night see herself as sitting on the ench—not very active. Someone else night feel he's a cheerleader, giving ncouragement to the team but not

participating. Others may identify with the coach, the quarterback, or even an empty seat in the stands. Then allow everyone to visualize where they would like to be in the game and why. You might want to prepare a photograph or drawing of a football stadium with players, coaches, and spectators for each group to use, or perhaps list possible participants in a football event to choose from. Close the experience with a round of affirming prayer for each other.
