GROUP SHOW-AND-TELL

GROUP BANNERS

Each group of 8 makes a banner with materials from a paper sack. In the sack are: one balloon, four different colors of tissue paper, a strip of white wrapping paper six feet long, and some masking tape. Your group decides upon a theme that expresses what you are experiencing together. You work out the design with the materials available and hang the banner on the wall.

COMMUNITY CONSTRUCTION

In groups of 4 assume that you can create a new church and community for your area. Consider the master plan for the community as well as the architectural design for the church.

Focus on the kind of church you would want in this community—the building, with the arrangement of the sanctuary, education rooms, etc. Don't worry about matters of tradition, negative reactions or cost.

Put everything into the model that you feel is important; leave everything out of the building that you feel is unimportant.

It would be helpful at the beginning for the leader to show a rough sketch of what they consider to be an ideal community and also a half-finished model of their ideas for a church building.
