## Iappy Handful Relay

This relay may be easily adapted for indoor or outdoor use. Assemble two entical sets of at least 12 miscellaneous items (i.e. two brooms, two balls, two illets, two rolls of bathroom tissue, two ladders, etc.). Use your imagination to illect an interesting variety of identical pairs of objects. Place the two sets of jects on two separate tables.
Line up a team for each table. The first player for each team runs to his table, cks up one item of his choice, runs back to his team, and passes the item to the cond player. The second player carries the first item back to the table, picks up 10ther item, and carries both items back to the third player. Each succeeding ayer carries the items collected by his teammates to the table, picks up one new and carries them all back to the next player. The game will begin rapidly, but e pace will slow as each player decides which item to add to a growing armload items. It will also take increasingly longer for one player to pass his burden to e next player in line.
Once picked up, an item may not touch the table or floor. Any item which is opped in transit or transfer must be returned to the table by the leader. No one ay assist the giving and receiving players in the exchange of items except rough coaching. The first team to empty its table wins.
