

# LANDMINES

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This game can be a great intro to a discussion about landmines of temptation, using Genesis 4:6-7 or 1 Peter 5:8 as texts, for example.

Set up the middle of your area with landmines of face-down paper plates that have an action or command written on them—it could be simple, complex, silly, slightly embarrassing...whatever. Divide your teenagers into two teams and have them line up in a line. Then each team sends one person to the middle to pick one of the plates and do whatever it says. You could play with the rule that each time someone does an action, that paper plate action is no longer available. The first team to have each person do an action wins.
