

Musical Hats

Give a hat to everyone in the room except for one person (or if you have several teams, have each team select one participant to enter the competition while the rest of the team cheers). Ask them to put it on and stand in a circle. This game is played like "musical chairs," but instead of a missing chair, there is a missing hat. When the whistle blows, everyone starts walking in a circle. With their right hand ONLY, they grab the hat on the head of the person in front of them and place the hat on their head. When the whistle blows again, the person without a hat on their head is OUT.

The object of the game is to keep a hat on your head by grabbing the hat on the head of the person in front of you and putting it on your head. You cannot hold your hat on your head. All you can do is to take the hat off of the head of the person in front of you and put their hat on your head.

Now, to start, get in a circle. Turn right and start walking at the sound of the whistle.

(*Leader:* Remove one hat from the group after each round so that there is one hat less than people. After each round, ask the person without a hat to step out.)
