

NITE LIFE TOUR

A Nite Life Tour is an intensive, fast-moving, 12-hour (6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.) tour of the night life in your town or city. Take a selected group of senior high students on a tour like the one suggested below. This experience will give your young people some valuable exposure to the "other side" as well as each other.

Suggested schedule:

- 6:00 p.m. Meet at the church. Orientation. Let the people know where they are going, what to look for, questions to think about.
- 6:30 p.m. Suicide prevention center
- 7:45 p.m. Movie (secular film at an established theater)
- 10:30 p.m. City morgue or emergency room at hospital
- 11:30 p.m. Snack
- 12:30 a.m. Police department
- 2:00 a.m. Airport control tower
- 3:00 a.m. Drug rehabilitation center
- 4:30 a.m. Breakfast
- 6:00 a.m. Home

Some additional suggestions: A TV studio, a church-operated coffeehouse, the telephone company, the local newspaper, interviews with city officials, Salvation Army, Goodwill Industries, a store-front church, a Friday evening or Saturday morning synagogue service, draft counseling service, post office, funeral home, bowling, swimming, a play or musical, a rap session with college students.

Follow up with a discussion of both the good and the bad of what was seen and heard. Obviously it would be best to have the discussion on another day, as the group will be pretty tired after
