Pass It On

The entire group forms a circle. Everyone is given an object of any shape or size—a bowling ball, a trash can, a shoe, and so on. At a signal, everyone passes her or his object to the person on her or his right, keeping the objects moving at all times. When a person drops any object, she or he is out, but the object remains in. As the game progresses, more people leave the game, making it harder and harder to avoid dropping an object. The winner is the last person left in the rame.
