

Ping-Pong Football

The ping-pong table is the football field. With string or masking tape, line off the table as you would a football field. You can even decorate the end zone. For goalposts, use straws stuck in clay with the crossbar fastened with pins.

Each team sits alternately around the table. The middle man at each end of the table (goal) is on the offensive, while the two on the outside are defensive.

With a ping-pong ball on the 50-yard line, the referee blows the whistle. Everyone, with hands under the table, and chin on the table, blows the ball toward the opponent's goal. If the ball falls off the table, place it where it fell off and continue. Score six points for every touchdown. If you want to, extra points can be tried by someone "kicking the ball" through the goalpost with their finger.

Five-minute quarters, substitutions and cheering sections enhance the enthusiasm.
