SCRAMBLED NAME

Here's a great little mixer for larger groups (15 or more) that don't know each other. Pass out slips of paper and pencils and have everyone write down their own name with the letters all mixed up. In other words, if your name is Harvey Furd, then you might write it as "Vreahy Urfd."

When all the names have been put in a hat, have each person draw one out. On the command of "go," the kids try to unscramble the name on their paper either by themselves or with help from others. Once they know the name of the person, they must seek that person out—either by shouting out the person's name or by asking individuals their names. Once they find the person, they must have the person sign the piece of paper.

The game can continue until a time limit is up
