
SPONTANEOUS POETRY

Break into small groups of seven to 10 and give each group a piece of paper. The first person in the group writes down a word at the top of the paper and passes it to the next person. The second person contemplates the first word, writes another word just below



the first word, and then folds the paper so the first word cannot be seen and only his own word is visible. This process is repeated for each person in the group, with each person carefully folding the paper so that only her own word can be seen. When the last word has been written the paper is unfolded and the "poem" is read.

A person can write any kind of word and should not spend a lot of time thinking of just the "right" word. The results are hilarious.
