TWISTED TWISTER GAME

Traditional Twister is intended for four players, but we have quite a few more show up for our outreach nights, so I got creative with the game.

Our room has 12-inch linoleum tiles, so I take a six-foot by six-foot section and run three strips of duct tape up and across to form nine squares. The same rules apply as the normal game. You can shake things up by putting down random colors instead of the same colors in rows. Or you could choose tape with weird patterns—zebra stripes and camouflage, for instance. Or you could arrange the squares in different patterns to form designs other than a grid.

You can pair this game with a devotion on how sin causes us to get all twisted up and left in uncomfortable positions.
