you must send a representative from your team with the item to one of the X's on the floor. If you get to one of the X's first, and you have the item, you'll get a token. At the end of the game, the team with the most tokens wins.

But be warned! You may not run or push people off an X. If all the X's are full, don't leave—someone might not have the correct item.

Some of the items on each list are written as riddles. Don't read aloud what's in the parentheses—that's what you're looking for. Let kids creatively figure out the puzzling scavenger-hunt items.

Choose a list of items to call out from any of the themes listed here. Mix and match items from different lists, or make up your own. This is a game that can be played over and over without repeating the same theme twice.
