Hand to Hand

Get your young people to think and talk about the youth group with this discussion starter. Have each person trace his hand on a piece of typing paper. Then, using each finger and the palm as a place to sketch, ask the kids to draw the following with paints, pens, or markers.

Finger 1: Symbolize something your youth group has done for others in the past.

Finger 2: Symbolize the purpose of our youth group.

Finger 3: Draw the most important activity of our youth group.

Finger 4: Draw a picture of our youth group's greatest achievement last year.

Thumb: Symbolize what you feel the goal of our group should be.

Palm: Write three words that should be most important to our group.

Once everyone has finished sketching their hands, ask them to explain their sketches, one finger at a time. Before they leave, ask your group members to cut out their hands and tape them hand to hand around the room.
