

I'VE GOT YOUR NUMBER

As kids arrive, each gets a number that they must wear in a conspicuous place on their clothes. Ahead of time, prepare lots of instructions on little slips of paper, then place them in a box. They should be things like:

- Borrow something from 1.
- Introduce 2 to 7.
- Have 6 get you a glass of water.
- Find out 12's middle name.

When everyone has their number, kids each take a slip of paper with an instruction on it. When they have completed the instruction, they come back and get a new one. At the end of the time limit (five minutes or so), whoever has completed the most instructions wins. Make sure you make plenty of instructions.
