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Have your kids bring a dollar's worth of change with them to youth group, and start things off with this version of Bingo. Give each person a game sheet (page 48), then have the group mingle and find people who have coins as described on the sheet, or who can answer the questions correctly. Five in a

row—up, down, or diagonally—wins.
