

TOILET PAPER INTRODUCTIONS

Here's a great way to do introductions at your next camp or retreat—it works especially well with middle schoolers.

When you're around the campfire, hand each teenager three squares of toilet paper. Then have them each share something that's unique about them—as they share a tidbit, have them crumple one square and throw it into the fire. You can continue going around the circle until all squares are gone, or ask a new question each round. With our group, momentum builds and our kids ask for more paper!
