This is a great way to get teenagers to open up at the beginning of a small group time.

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Get enough small cans of various-colored Play-Doh to give one to each person. Ask teenagers to use the clay to model a representation of something God has done in their lives this week. Give them five minutes to create something, and then go around and share. I've found that it's often easier for teenagers to talk about their experiences once they've used their hands to mold a representation of it.
