motivating youth

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- 1. Motivation to do a job comes from without; motivation to do a good job comes from within
- 2. Remember with a child's heart
- 3. Start out at their level, not yours
- 4. Invest heavily in them; Positive investments make for positive returns
- 5. See them as they might be, not as they are
- 6. Show love in many ways; be creative
- 7. Remember that your 100% is not their 100%
- 8. Do not be afraid to self-disclose; then you become real to them

THE TWELVE COMMANDMENTS OF MOTIVATING

- 1. Do not attempt to motivate youth without first being motivated.
- 2. Have a message to instill within the hearts of the young.
- 3. D not prejudge any youth based on race, relatives, or socioeconomic status.
- 4. Do not think yourself always right.
- 5. Govern yourself as though you were someone's significant other (because you probably are.)
- 6. Regard youth unconditionally.
- 7. Do not refer to youth as Clients
- 8. Walk the Walk., if you Talk the Talk
- 9. Look on youth as they will be (after you have touched them, not before)
- 10. Strive to reach the whole child.
- 11. Use your experience to teach, not preach.
- 12. Be truthful.
