## ENCOUNTER

An encounter with an adolescent requires openness, a presence and a real availability. Adolescents seek out catechists who can authentically share their own faith story - the struggles., hopes and doubts that they experience in their own lives. Adolescents seek to be appreciated for who they are - persons loved by God.
