

- The abortion rate is now the lowest since the 1973 Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision.
- The divorce rate is the lowest since 1980, when half of all first marriages ended in divorce—that number has now dropped to 40 percent.
- Drug abuse among teenagers has declined since the 1990's, along with the teenage birth rate.
- The murder rate is the lowest in 45 years.

Wehner credits a major "shift in public attitudes" for much of the improvement—and that "public attitude" was shaped, in part, by you. God is good, and he's alive and well in youth ministry. ■
