

Teenagers Want Trust and Freedom

Kids want more trust and freedom in families, according to a Group Publishing survey of 360 kids at the 1987 National Christian Youth Congress.

The following percentage of kids surveyed "strongly agree" or "agree" with "I wish my parents (or guardian) would . . ."

- trust me more—65%
 - give me more freedom—63%
 - say "I love you" more often—59%
 - give me more responsibility—56%
 - be more interested in the things I care about—54%
 - spend more time with me—49%
 - yell at me less often—39%
 - talk with me more about their views on important issues such as sex and drugs—37%
